Sheffield 11th May 2017

**Clinical Cases: Dermatology Clinic, C Floor Outpatient Dept,
Royal Hallamshire Hospital (RHH), Sheffield S10 2JF**

Tea & Discussion: Halifax Hall, Endcliffe Vale Rd, Sheffield S10 3ER

Parking for both: The Edge, 34 Endcliffe Crescent, Sheffield S10 3ED

Please note that there is very limited parking at or close to the Royal Hallamshire Hospital.

However, we have arranged for free parking near to Halifax Hall, in front of "The Edge", Endcliffe Crescent (access from Fulwood Road). Please see the attached maps and websites. Car parking areas with an 'R' may be used. **A permit is also attached. Please print it off, bring it with you, and display it in your car window.**

The RHH is about 15 minutes walk from the car park.

We have also arranged for shuttle buses to take you:-

1. From adjacent The Edge Parking to RHH at 1415 (Leaving from Coach Stand, Oakholme Rd – see map on first website below)
2. From RHH to Halifax Hall at 1515 and 1545, in time for tea and case discussion. (Leaving from turning circle, B Road, RHH)

If required, there is disabled parking in and near the Royal Hallamshire Hospital multi-storey car park. There are also a small number of parking spaces directly in front of Halifax Hall itself (please display the parking permit).

Directions to Halifax Hall

Address: Endcliffe Vale Road, Sheffield S10 3ER (but parking is the The Edge, S10 3ED)

By Car

The directions below take you to the free parking in front of “the Egde” which is a meeting venue close to Halifax Hall (all part of the University Halls of Residence, please see the attached maps and websites).

The Edge: 34 Endcliffe Crescent, Sheffield, S10 3ED.

Please print off the attached permit, bring it with you, and display it in your windscreen.

It is a short walk from the car park through the Halls of residence to Halifax Hall, and a 15 minute walk to the Royal Hallamshire Hospital (or please use shuttle buses to be provided).

From the North, South or East

Leave the M1 at junction 33. Follow the A630/A57/A61. At the Park Square roundabout take the A61(S). Pass the railway station on your left. Then turn right onto the ring road (A6134), following signs for the ring road (A61 Barnsley). At the third round about turn left (first exit), onto Western Bank. At the fourth set of traffic lights (not counting pedestrian crossings), take the left fork to Fulwood (rather than the right fork up Manchester Road or A57). Endcliffe Crescent is the second turning on the left.

From the West

Follow the A57. Turn right into Shore Lane, then left onto Fulwood Road. Endcliffe Crescent is the first turning on the right.

By public transport

The nearest tram stop is University. Trams run about every 10 minutes to and from Sheffield railway station directly to this stop (10-12 minute journey). Tickets are bought on board. From this stop the hospital is a 7-10 minute walk away on a slight incline.

There are tram or bus Park and Ride options (with free parking) at several sites as listed below:

From the M1:

Meadowhall (J34), Barrow Road S9 1EP

Trams run every 10 minutes to and from Sheffield City Centre and Middlewood (daytime frequency). Trains run direct to Sheffield, Rotherham, Barnsley, Doncaster, Huddersfield, Leeds, Lincoln and Worksop.

Valley Centertainment, Attercliffe Common, S9 2EP

Trams run every 10 minutes to and from Sheffield City Centre, Meadowhall and Middlewood (daytime frequency).

From the A61 South (by bus):

Tesco Supermarket, Abbeydale Road, S7 2QB

Buses run every 30 minutes to and from the Hallamshire Hospital and the University of Sheffield (daytime frequency).

By car

Parking is limited in and around the hospital, so we recommend either using public transport if at all possible, or parking at "The Edge", as above.

The hospital is on Glossop Road (B6069). The postcode for satellite navigation is S10 2JF.

From the M1 South – Exit the motorway at J33 and follow the A630 and A57 into Sheffield. At the Park Square roundabout take the A61(S), passing the railway station on your left. Follow signs for the ring road (A61 Barnsley) and you will soon see signs to the hospitals.

From the M1 North – Exit the motorway at J34 and follow the A6109 towards the city centre, passing Meadowhall. Follow signs for the ring road and you will soon see signs to the hospitals.

From the A61 South – Follow the A61 into the city. Just after the Halfords superstore, turn left on Bramall Lane (A621), passing the football stadium on your right. At the roundabout take the first exit and follow the A61 Barnsley. You will soon see signs to the hospitals.

Parking charges for the multi-storey hospital car park (which is often full) are:

0-2 hrs:	£2.50
2-4 hrs:	£3.70
4-24 hrs:	£8.40

Please note that the car park machines do not accept 5p coins or £20 notes, nor do they accept credit/debit cards.
